Following are fees to be charged for services provided by the district courts. No fees are to be charged for services rendered on behalf of the United States, with the exception of those specifically prescribed in items 4(b), 4(e), and 4(f). No fees under this schedule shall be charged to federal agencies or programs which are funded from judiciary appropriations, including, but not limited to, agencies, organizations, and individuals providing services authorized by the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, and Bankruptcy Administrator programs.

- a. Civil Complaint \$150.00
- b. Habeas Corpus Petition \$5.00
- c. Cuban Liberty and Democratic Solidarity (LIBERTAD) Act 1996¹ \$5,431.00

2. APPEAL FILING FEES

- a. District Court Docket Fee \$5.00
 - b. Appellate Court Filing Fee \$250.00
- NOTE:** Both the District Court filing fee and the Appellate Court filing fees are to be combined (\$255.00) and tendered to the Clerk, U. S. District Court.
- c. Appeal to District Judge from Conviction by US Magistrate Judge in a Misdemeanor or Petty Offense \$32.00

3. ATTORNEY ADMISSIONS FEES

- a. Admission of Attorney to Practice \$200.00
- b. Renewal/Reinstatement Admissions \$100.00
- c. Special Admission - Pro Hac Vice \$100.00
- d. Duplicate Certificate of Admissions \$15.00
- e. Certificate of Good Standing \$15.00

⁵For reproduction of recordings of proceedings, regardless of the medium, \$26, including the cost of materials. This fee shall apply to services rendered on behalf of the United States, if the reproduction of the recording is available electronically.
