Standing Order 2021-16


Due to changes in participation of banks in the Treasury General Account program, the Court will no longer accept payments in cash as of December 1, 2021.

If a payor sends a cash payment to the Clerk's Office by mail or by a commercial courier service, or if a payor leaves a cash payment in a dropbox located in any District of Oregon courthouse, the Court will attempt to return the payment to the payor.

Because the Court cannot accept cash payments, the payor bears the risk of loss if the Court's attempt to return the cash to the payor is not successful.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
