Whether the Supreme Court should bar Ohio Secretary of State Frank LaRose and the Franklin County Board of Elections from removing Sam Ronan, a candidate for Congress in the state's 15th district, from Ohio's Republican primary election ballot.

DECISION

Application for preliminary injunction denied on April 9, 2026.

Whether the Supreme Court should block a land swap involving a Native American sacred site.

DECISION

Application for injunction pending appeal denied by Justice Kagan on March 19, 2026.

Mirabelli v. Bonta



Whether the Supreme Court should vacate a stay from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit that paused a ruling that would have required educators to notify parents if their child changes the name or pronouns they're using in school.

DECISION

Justice Barrett wrote a concurring opinion, joined by Chief Justice Roberts and Justice Kavanaugh. Justice Kagan wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justice Jackson.

Malliotakis v. Williams



Whether the Supreme Court should stay an order from the Supreme Court of New York, County of New York preventing state officials from conducting any election under a congressional map approved by the New York Legislature in 2024.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on March 2, 2026. Justice Alito wrote a concurring opinion. Justice Sotomayor wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Kagan and Jackson.

Kosinski v. Williams



Whether the Supreme Court should stay an order from the Supreme Court of New York, County of New York preventing state officials from conducting any election under a congressional map approved by the New York Legislature in 2024.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on March 2, 2026. Justice Alito wrote a concurring opinion. Justice Sotomayor wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Kagan and Jackson.

G.W. v. Coronado Unified School District

Whether the Supreme Court should stay enforcement and collection of attorney-fee awards, enforcement of sanctions against Tracy L. Henderson, and related enforcement proceedings while applicants seek Supreme Court review.

Application for stay denied by Justice Kagan on Feb. 25, 2026.

Application for writ of injunction denied on Feb. 4, 2026.

NRA Group, LLC v. Durenleau

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a mandate from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 3rd Circuit preventing NRA Group, LLC, from challenging two former employees' actions under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act.

DECISION

Application for stay denied by Justice Alito on Jan. 28, 2026.

NO. 25A720

Barbers Hill Independent School District v. Arnold

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a ruling requiring a former volunteer school board president and a superintendent to sit for depositions about the underlying motivations behind a school board policy on male students' hair length.

DECISION

Application for stay denied by Justice Alito on Jan. 14, 2026.

PG Publishing Co., Inc. v. National Labor Relations Board

Whether the Supreme Court should pause an injunction requiring changes to the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's employee health insurance plan.

DECISION

NO. 25A443

Trump v. Illinois



Whether the Supreme Court should stay a district court order preventing the Trump administration from federalizing and deploying the National Guard within Illinois.

DECISION

Application for stay denied on Dec. 23, 2025. Justice Kavanaugh wrote an opinion concurring in the judgment. Justice Alito wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justice Thomas. Justice Gorsuch wrote a dissenting opinion.

NO. 25A662

Margolin v. National Association of Immigration Judges

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a mandate from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 4th Circuit that would send a dispute over a policy governing speaking engagements by immigration judges back to a federal trial court for fact-finding.

DECISION

Application for stay denied on Dec. 19, 2025.

Kanayama v. Kowal

Whether the Supreme Court should stay the extradition of Masahide Kanayama to Japan.

DECISION

Application for stay of extradition denied by Justice Sotomayor on Dec. 12, 2025.

NO. 25A608

Abbott v. League of United Latin American Citizens



Whether the Supreme Court should pause a three-judge district court ruling barring Texas from using its new congressional map in the 2026 elections.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on Dec. 4, 2025. Justice Alito wrote a concurring opinion, joined by Justices Thomas and Gorsuch. Justice Kagan wrote a dissenting opinion,

NO. 25A561

Chamber of Commerce of the United States v. Sanchez

Whether the Supreme Court should prohibit enforcement of two California laws requiring businesses to publish reports on a wide range of climate-related topics.

DECISION

Application for injunction withdrawn on Nov. 18, 2025.

NO. 25A515

Duran v. United States

Whether the Supreme Court should pause enforcement of a judgment granting control of \$40 million in funds from the estate of Ferdinand Marcos held in an account in New York to the Republic of the Philippines while Filipino human rights victims who won a \$2 billion judgment against the estate appeal the judgment.

DECISION

Application for stay of judgment denied by Justice Sotomayor on Nov. 14, 2025.

NO. 25A376

Castro v. Guevara

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a mandate from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 5th Circuit that would require a 7-year-old girl residing in Dallas, Texas, with her mother to be sent back to Venezuela.

DECISION

Application for stay denied on Nov. 13, 2025. Justices Sotomayor and Jackson would grant the application.

NO. 25A539

Rollins v. Rhode Island State Council of Churches

Whether the Supreme Court should pause a district court's orders requiring the Trump administration to fully fund November Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) payments.

DECISION

Justice Jackson granted the Trump administration's request for an administrative stay on Nov. 7, 2025. On Nov. 11, the court extended the administrative stay. Jackson

Jones v. Lafferty

Whether the Supreme Court should stay the enforcement of a judgment of \$1,436,650,000 against Alex Jones.

DECISION

Application to stay collection denied by Justice Sotomayor on Oct. 14, 2025.

NO. 25A354

Google LLC v. Epic Games, Inc.

Whether the Supreme Court should partially stay a permanent injunction requiring changes to the Google Play app store.

DECISION

Application for partial stay denied on Oct. 6, 2025.

NO. 25A326

Noem v. National TPS Alliance



Whether the Supreme Court should stay the district court's order barring the Secretary of Homeland Security from terminating a portion of the Temporary Protected Status designations for Venezuelan nationals.

DECISION

Application for stay is granted on Oct. 3, 2025. Justices Sotomayor and Kagan would deny the application. Justice Jackson wrote a dissenting opinion.

NO. 25A331

Medina v. United States

Whether the Supreme Court will issue a certificate of appealability to permit Jacob Matthew Medina's petition for habeas relief to proceed.

DECISION

Application for a certificate of appealability denied by Justice Kagan on Sept. 29, 2025.

NO. 25A269

Department of State v. AIDS Vaccine Advocacy Coalition

administration to make available for obligation billions of dollars in appropriated foreign-aid funds.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on Sept. 26, 2025. Justice Kagan wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Sotomayor and Jackson.

NO. 25A264

Trump v. Slaughter



Whether the Supreme Court should stay a ruling by a federal appeals court that requires the Trump administration to reinstate a commissioner on the Federal Trade Commission whom President Donald Trump fired this spring.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on Sept. 22, 2025. Justice Kagan wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Sotomayor and Jackson.

NO. 25A287

New Jersey Transit Corporation v. Colt

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a state trial in which the New Jersey Transit Corporation is a defendant where the court has granted certiorari to determine whether NJ Transit has sovereign immunity.

DECISION

Application for stay granted on Sept. 19, 2025.

NO. 25A234

South Carolina v. Doe

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a federal appeals court's injunction that requires a public school in the state to allow a transgender student to use the boys' bathroom while challenging a state law that requires students to use bathrooms based on their biological sex at birth.

DECISION

Application for stay pending appeal is denied on Sept. 10, 2025. Justices Thomas, Alito, and Gorsuch would grant the application.

Whether the Supreme Court should stay the extradition of Melvin Martinez-Guardado to Honduras pending appeal.

DECISION

Application for stay of extradition denied by Justice Alito on Sept. 10, 2025.

NO. 25A169

Noem v. Perdomo



Whether the Supreme Court should stay a district court order preventing federal immigration officers from relying on any combination of four factors – “apparent race or ethnicity,” speaking in Spanish or accented English, presence at a location where undocumented immigrants “are known to gather,” and working at specific jobs, such as landscaping or construction – to justify conducting detentive stops in seven southern California counties, including Los Angeles.

DECISION

Application for stay of district court order granted on Sept. 8, 2025. Justice Kavanaugh wrote a concurring opinion. Justice Sotomayor wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Kagan and Jackson.

NO. 25A227

Trump v. Global Health Council

Whether the Supreme Court should stay a district court order requiring the Trump administration to make available for obligation tens of billions of dollars in appropriated foreign-aid funds.

DECISION

Application for stay withdrawn on Aug. 29, 2025.

NO. 25A231

Avon Capital, LLC v. Universitas Education, LLC

Whether the Supreme Court should stay an order requiring a payment from SDM Holdings on behalf of Avon Capital, LLC to Universitas Education, LLC.

DECISION

NO. 25A103

National Institutes of Health v. American Public Health Association



Whether the Supreme Court should stay district court judgments blocking the National Institutes of Health from terminating grants

DECISION

Application for stay of district court judgments is granted in part and denied in part on Aug. 21, 2025. Chief Justice Roberts and Justices Sotomayor, Kagan, and Jackson would deny in full. Justices Thomas, Alito, Gorsuch, and Kavanaugh would grant in full.

NO. 25A187

Hessler v. United States

Whether the Supreme Court will issue a certificate of appealability to permit Simon Hessler's petition for habeas relief to proceed.

DECISION

Application for a certificate of appealability denied by Justice Sotomayor on Aug. 21, 2025.

NO. 25A97

NetChoice, LLC v. Fitch



Whether the Supreme Court should reinstate a preliminary injunction blocking Mississippi's online age verification law from taking effect

DECISION

Application to vacate an appeals court's stay of a preliminary injunction denied on Aug. 14, 2025. Justice Kavanaugh wrote a concurring opinion.

NO. 25A62

Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians v. Howe

Whether the Supreme Court should stay an appeals court mandate stating that private plaintiffs cannot rely on 42 U.S.C. § 1983 to file suit under Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act.



Justices Thomas, Alito, and Gorsuch would deny the application.

NO. 25A11

Trump v. Boyle



Whether the Supreme Court should stay the district court's judgment reinstating three members of the Consumer Product Safety Commission who had been removed by President Donald Trump.

DECISION

Application for stay pending appeal is granted on July 23, 2025. Justice Kagan wrote a dissenting opinion, joined by Justices Sotomayor and Jackson.
