Standing Order 2016-10

The U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon (Court) — in cooperation with the Oregon Chapter of the Federal Bar Association (FBA) — has established the FBA *Pro Bono* Scholarship Program. The FBA *Pro Bono* Scholarship Program is a scholarship fund administered by the FBA, the professional organization for litigators who practice before the Court, created to increase the number of recently licensed attorneys participating in federal *pro bono* service. Pursuant to the FBA *Pro Bono* Scholarship Program, the FBA sponsors up to five attorneys per year who are interested in providing *pro bono* services through the Court's *Pro Bono* Program.

The FBA pays the statutory portion of the general admission fee on behalf of the attorneys they select for participation in the program. The Court waives the local portion of the general admission fee for the FBA's approved scholarship recipients. This standing order will continue indefinitely until either the Court or the FBA terminates its participation in the program.
