JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

You are a potential juror in an upcoming civil case in federal court. Service on a jury is one of the most important contributions that a citizen can provide to his or her country and fellow citizens. Inconvenience or ordinary financial issues related to jury service will not be enough to excuse a prospective juror. In addition, federal law forbids any employer from discharging or discriminating against an employee because of jury service.

This questionnaire is intended to make jury selection in this case more efficient and fair. In this questionnaire, the Court is asking you about your background as it may relate to your possible service as a juror in this case. The use of this questionnaire will avoid having to ask each prospective juror every one of these questions in open court, thereby shortening the jury selection process.

Because this questionnaire is part of the jury selection process, the questionnaire is to be answered under your oath as a prospective juror to tell the truth. Please respond to each question as fully and completely as possible.

There are no right or wrong answers to the questions asked in this juror questionnaire, provided they are truthful and complete. Please do not leave any question blank. If a question does not apply to you, please write "N/A," rather than leaving the question blank.

All answers will be kept confidential, and your answers will be reviewed only by the Court and the parties. You may, however, be asked follow-up questions in open court.

Because you may be selected to be a juror in this case, you must not discuss the questions in this questionnaire with anyone, including your family, friends, employer, or even your fellow jurors, until after the trial has ended or you have been told that you have not been selected as a juror. Also, you may not even listen to any information or conversation about this case other than what is presented in court during trial.

In addition, because you may be selected to be a juror in this case, do not do any research, investigation, or reading of any kind, on the Internet or anywhere else, about any of the issues mentioned in this questionnaire.

These procedures are necessary to ensure a fair trial for all parties. Thank you, in advance, for your cooperation.
