## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that members of the Court-sponsored Mediation Panel may request exemption from PACER fees for conducting research related to cases assigned by this Court for mediation pursuant to LR 16-4(e)(3). Panel members may request an exempt account by submitting a "Request for PACER Exemption" form.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by submitting a request for PACER exempt status, the mediator certifies that he/she will not use this exempt account for research not specifically intended to aid in their understanding of a case assigned to them for mediation pursuant to LR 16-4(e)(3). Furthermore, the mediator agrees not to sell any of the content acquired from PACER via the exempt account, to comply with all rules and guidelines established by PACER, and to utilize his/her normal PACER account for any research that is not directly associated with

a case referred for mediation pursuant to LR 16-4(e)(3). Any violation of these terms will result in revocation of the mediator's exempt PACER account and removal from the Court-sponsored Mediator Panel list.
